Funding — where is funding coming from for renovations -need at least \$200,000 for minimum renos -working with vision solution to see if we need a feasibility study done- and who will fund it? -there is a lot of good intent in club to make this rebuild happen -400 plus members who will help -engagement with members is important part the renovations - don't pay for feasibility study if we don't have to easier to get some stuff done, but we have to look at bigger picture -susan Devoy said Squash NZ might pay, when approached they said no -emply prfessionals -grants knowledge in house is good, Waikato is very different to Taurangabig plans to see what we can get, look to plan for 60 – 100 years but be realistic too -have we approached grassroots, no but will.
